

# Camp Lakewood Packing List and Phone Number

**September 25 – 27, 2012**

**Leaving Tuesday, Sept. 25 at 8:00 am**

**Returning Thursday, Sept. 27 at 2:15 pm**

Please pack lightly and bring clothes that can be worn more than one day. There is limited space on the bus for bags. Every piece of luggage needs to be labeled with students full name and clearly marked.

You will need to eat breakfast at home or arrive early and eat at school. All other meals are covered.

## **What to Bring:**

Groups will be outside most of the time and must bring rugged clothes that can get dirty. Activities usually continue as planned regardless of the weather.

- 1 sleeping bag
- 1 pillow/pillow case
- 1 towels and 1 washcloth
- Soap, shampoo, comb, brush, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant etc.
- 2 pairs of jeans or long pants
- 3-4 t-shirts and at least one sweatshirt
- 2 pairs of shorts
- Jacket
- 1 long sleeve shirt
- 4 pairs of socks
- Pajamas
- Underwear for each day
- 1 pair of shoes or backed-sandals (no flip-flops!) we will wear as our "wet" shoes during water ecology.
- 1 pair of shoes that stay dry. Closed-toed shoes that fasten tightly - no "five-fingers", etc. \*This is a requirement for the climbing tower\*
- Refillable water bottle
- Small, sturdy backpack for day pack
- Raincoat or water resistant/proof jacket
- Flip flops or shower shoes
- Flashlight
- Alarm Clock
- Watch
- Baseball cap/sunglasses
- 1 labeled gallon-sized Zip-Loc bags (for wet clothes)

## **OPTIONAL ITEMS:**

- Personal entertainment (books, magazines, playing cards)
- Extra money (IF you are bringing any. There is a gift shop at Camp Lakewood. There are NO vending machines.
- Camera/Film
- Prescription medication (to be given to nurse the morning we leave - must be labeled)
- Fan for room (personal size only)
- Electronics for bus ride only (No personal DVD players or laptops)

## **WHAT NOT TO BRING:**

- "Good clothes"
- Snacks, food, gum, or candy (this attracts insects and other animals to the cabins)
- Soda, energy drinks, etc – These will be confiscated and NOT returned.
- Hair dryers, curling irons, or other electrical equipment.
- Slick-soled shoes.
- Weapons of any kind.
- Cigarettes, illegal drugs, or alcoholic beverages.
- Expensive personal belongings.

**Upon arrival we will be collecting all electronics, including cell phones. These items are stored in a locked box while we are at Camp Lakewood. All electronics will be returned for the bus trip home.**
