## STUDENT MENTORS AT MRH HIGH SCHOOL **LINK CREW**

There are 3 types of mentoring available to qualified and interested students at MRH High:

1. Student academic mentor- The student works one on one with a recommended student in a specific subject area. The student may have a teacher referral for a student mentor in a certain subject or may be a BDC student needing some academic support.
2. New student mentor-these upper class mentors typically work with 9<sup>th</sup> graders in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisory and plan and carry out the 9<sup>th</sup> grade student day in August. They meet with 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisories to discuss high school life and aid students with high school adjustments.
3. Cadet teacher mentors-these students are requested by teachers to help with the daily running of the classroom. They are held to high expectations and expected to work with the teacher to facilitate the effective flow of daily classroom lessons. They are there to support the teacher via tutoring students, working individually with students, helping with paperwork, and any other duties as the lead teacher sees fit.

- Buddy mentors to focus on students with behavioral/personal issues
- Link Crew mentors to work with high school transition and 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisories
- Cadet teachers to serve as teacher aides and classroom support
- Cornerstone Culture Class and Semester Service Class to serve in the great community and within our high school community
