What is Dream Big Career Camp?

The Dream Big Career Camps serve transition-age students with disabilities who plan to attend 2- or 4-year college or trade/technical school. The goal of Dream Big is to help students explore the range of career options that are available. To do this, we host week-long camps during the summer where students visit top employers in the St. Louis region to engage with disability welcoming workplaces. Each week has a different focus: STEM-focused, trade and tech-focused, and a miscellaneous mix for students who are not quite sure about a future field of interest.

Who should attend Dream Big?

- Students with disabilities between the ages of 14-21
- Participating students must intend to attend or be enrolled in a 2- or 4-year college/university or trade/technical school or other forms post-secondary education

When is Dream Big?

- Week 1 (9:00am-3:00pm) Dream Big Virtual Camp: June 5-9 | For students interested in learning about a variety of careers
- Week 2 (8:00am-4:00pm) Dream Big Innovate: June 26-30 | For students interested in STEM careers
 Companies may include: Boeing, Bayer, Wells Fargo, Cigna, and Riot Games
- Week 3 (8:00am-4:00pm) Dream Big Hands On: July 10-14 | For students interested in trade and technical careers
 - Companies may include: STLCC Culinary Arts and Hospitality, Ameren, Mercy, Nestle Support Center, Bi-State Development, and Petropolis/The Academy of Pet Careers

Where is Dream Big located?

Week 1 will be hosted VIRTUALLY via Zoom. Students will be able to join from the comfort of their own homes. Weeks 2 and 3 will be hosted at Missouri Botanical Garden's Education Center, where families can drop off and pick up campers. Students and Dream Big staff will be together as a group with companies participating either virtually or on-site. Accessible transportation to and from company site visits will be provided for all campers.

How much does Dream Big cost?

Week 1: Virtual Camp – Cost is \$100; Weeks 2 and 3 – Cost is \$500 per week. Information about tuition assistance is available upon request.
