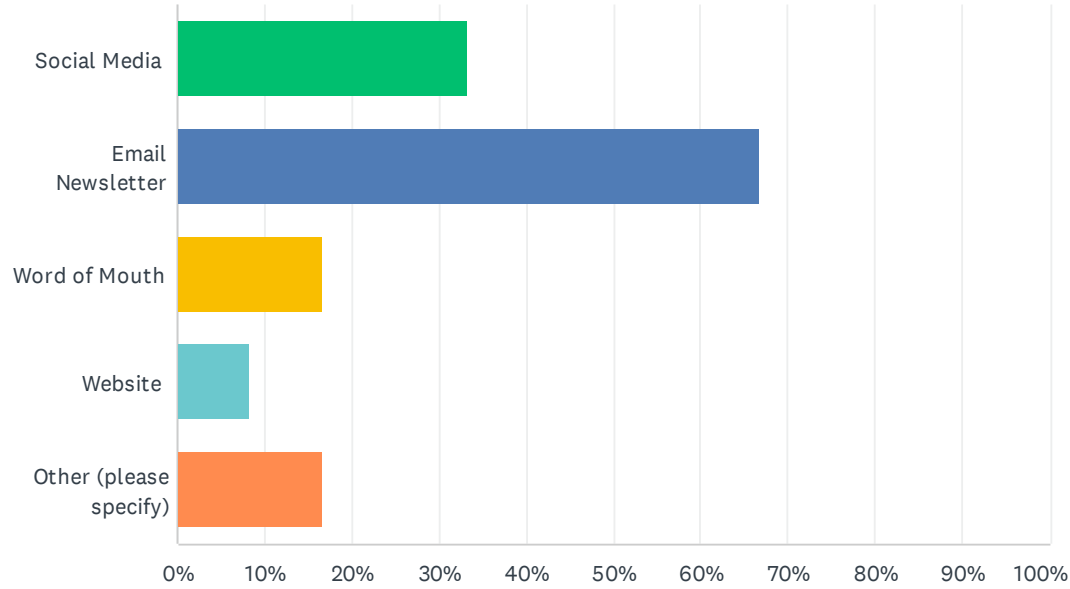


### Q1 How did you hear about this event? (Select all that apply)

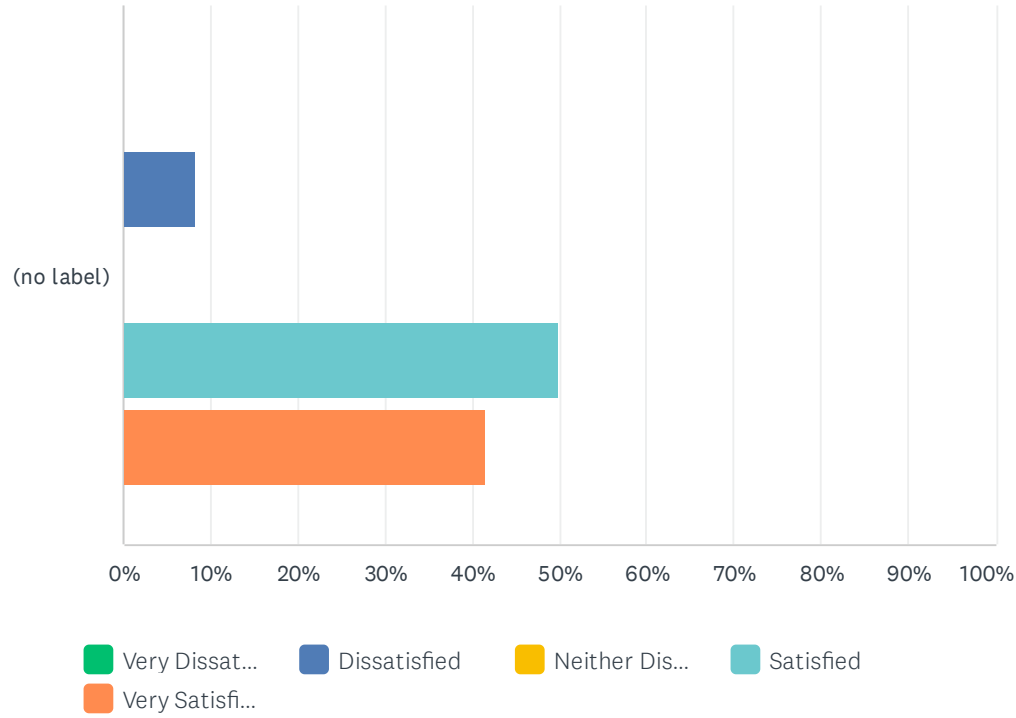

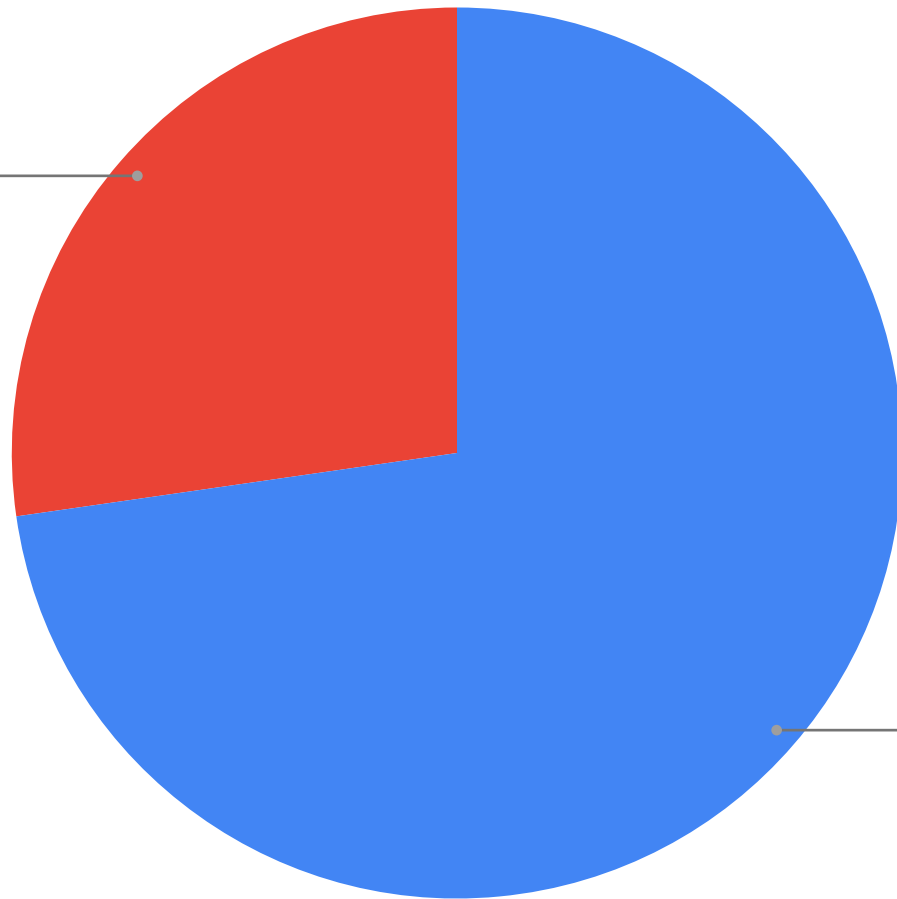

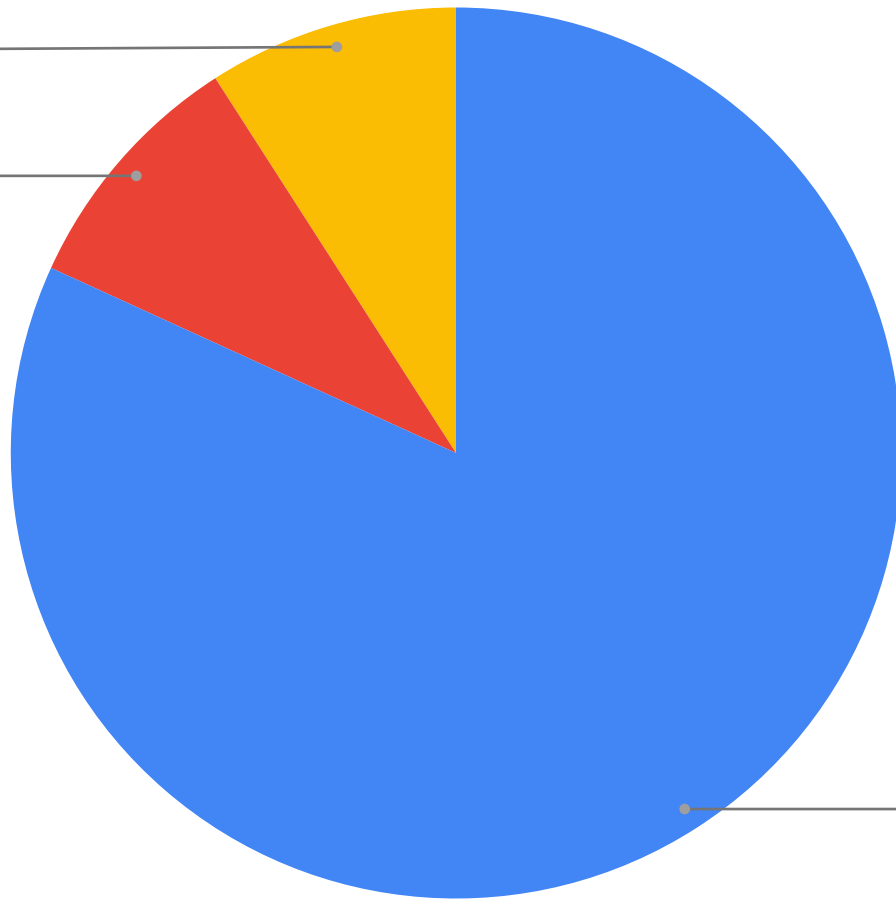
