		MS/HS Entrance Replacement Concrete -WTI informs cannot replace as is and meet ADA. If they touch it, they have to meet ADAWTI says they bid only replacement. No engineering or additional work to meet ADA. They request and engineers drawing from MRH and want an extra for the asphalt workMRH and NAVIGATE's position is that the WTI proposal and scope should include all required work to meet ADA. The recently completed work clearly indicated added asphalt required. Also, as noted by the concrete sub, if they touch it they have to make it meet ADA, so they should have includedAll that said, the team discussed options including: (1) Replace current section just as was done before. (2) Leave the existing ADA ramp and concrete in front of it (it is in good shape) and replace only the two sections on each side. (3) Eliminate two ADA spaces and pour back as standard parking. NOT ACCEPTABLE. (4) Move the two ADA spaces across the drive, or down the street and pour back this area as standard parking. CAN'T DO BECAUSE THE EXISTING GRADES DO NOT WORKMRH will try to meet with Brian (City) on Monday to discuss Options 1 & 2 and see if he will approve.
