Electives:

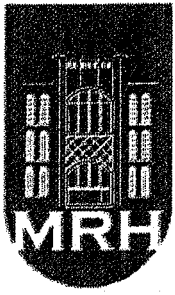
- **Students enrolled in HS credit French 1**
