




#### **Percent Proficient or Advanced - All Grade Levels**



#### **Percent Proficient or Advanced - Student Groups All Grade Levels**




#### Percent Proficient or Advanced - Student Groups All Grade Levels





#### **Subgroup Proficiency Over Time**






### Annual Performance Report (APR)

- 3. Primary factor in classification of school districts

- Contains data from 22-23 only, not a three year average
- Includes 12 additional points, Growth in Science and Social Studies
