Advisory:

- An 8 or 14 pack of dry erase markers- any colors

Every class:

- A working supply of pencils and pens throughout the year.

- A 1 4-pack of dry erase markers (any colors)
- 1 pair of earbud-style headphones

Core classes:

- 1 package of graph paper - **Math**
- 4 composition notebooks (200 pages each), 1 for **Social Studies, Comm. Arts, Math, and Science**
- Black ink pens for **Science**
- School appropriate swimsuit and towel for **PE (This will be for September swim unit)**

Electives:

- **Students enrolled in HS credit French 1**
 - 1 spiral, lined paper notebook, writing utensils
- **Students enrolled in French Foundation, Spanish Foundation, or Spanish 1**
 - 1 three-prong pocket folder with loose-leaf notebook paper
 - Earbuds for listening activities
- **E4 Students need the following supplies for E4:**
 - 1 pack #2 pencils or 1 pack blue/black pens
 - Earbuds for listening activities
 - 1 pack of post-it sticky notes (2 inch by 2 inch or larger)

Expeditions (you will need these items later in the year):

- Backpack/Daypack
- 2 refillable water bottles

- 1 expandable accordion pocket file with 5-8 slots
- Students are encouraged to have individual hand sanitizers if possible (there will be sanitizing stations scattered throughout the building.)

- 1 pack of 5 tabs or divider sheets for 3 ring binder - **Math**
- 1 package of graph paper - **Math**
- 4 **plastic covered composition** notebooks (200 pages each), 1 for **Expeditions**, 1 for **Social Studies**, 1 for **Comm. Arts**, and 1 for **Science**. (**NOT SPIRAL**) The plastic covers are necessary for notebook survival.

 - 1 three-prong pocket folder with loose-leaf notebook paper
 - Earbuds for listening activities
- **E4 Students need the following supplies for E4:**
