## Find out About SNAP/Food Stamps

Changes have been made to SNAP to make sure your family has groceries during the COVID-19 pandemic!



Your food stamp benefits will not be cancelled during the COVID-19 pandemic.

If you're up for recertification in March, April or May, your benefits will be extended for 6 months and verification documents do not need to be submitted right now.

### **Taxpayers in 2018 or 2019**

The check will be deposited in your bank account or mailed to your house.

### **Social Security Enrollees**

The payment will be included with your Social Security benefits.

### **Everyone Else**

Complete the "Non-Filers: Payment Info" form on the IRS website.

### **Add or Update Payment Information**
