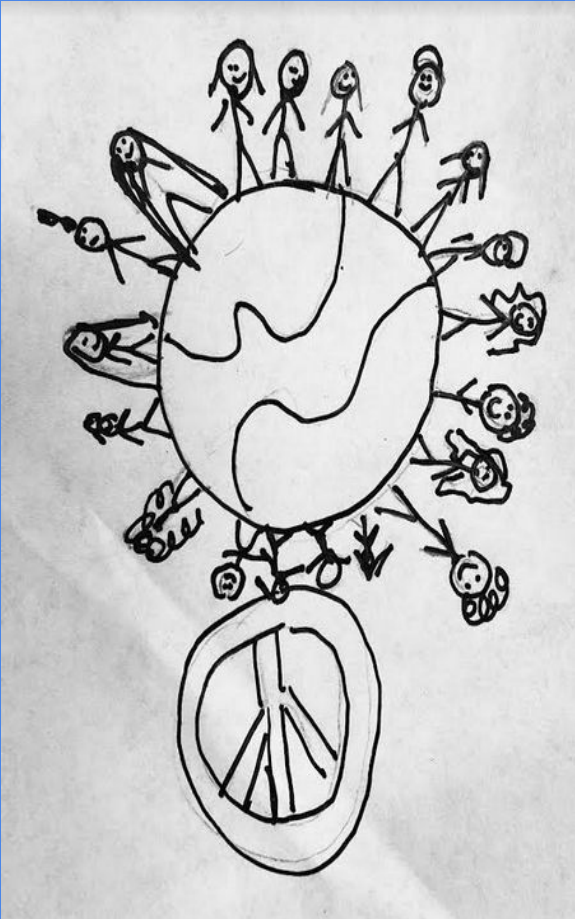

All day (exception: meals)



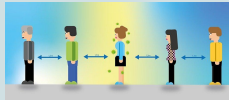
HAND HYGIENE

Upon arrival, and in classrooms
Sinks in all classrooms
Bottle-filler stations



RESPIRATORY ETIQUETTE

Pre-teaching, mini-lessons
Visuals around the building



SOCIAL DISTANCING

Desk spacing
Plexiglass
Directional Signage in hallways
Signage



CLEANING

Classrooms: after lunch, each night
Set schedule for common spaces



HEALTH SCREENING

Staff-daily screens
Families will complete screen at home

ECC Tier 1:

All students in school, all day, 5 days per week

Children enter school and move directly to classrooms, no waiting in halls

Safe-distancing protocols for hallway passing, locker use, & bathroom usage

Small groups will work in identified classroom spaces with 3 ft of social distancing

Cohorting will remain in place for outside recess; 6 separate play spaces will be identified and classes will rotate through the various areas across the week

No visitors or volunteers will be allowed in the building

Educational Partners will have limited access to buildings

Specials in Tier 1:

Specials will return to the A/B/C week schedule for both Tier 1 & MRH Virtual Academy.

Specials for Virtual Academy will remain as LIVE zooms

PE & Seed to Table will be outside weather permitting and in the classrooms as needed

Art, Music, Library & Guidance will be in the classrooms and outside when appropriate



Learning in a safe environment:



Classroom layout is designed to ensure 3ft of social distancing through use of a combination of 2-person tables with plexiglass partitions and individual desks



Individual learning supplies (pencils, glue sticks, scissors) will be in a sealable container.

Shared supplies will be limited to classroom cohorts and regularly sanitized.

Learning will be grounded in School As Studio metaphor.

Health/Hygiene & Food Services:

Protocols and procedures are in place for ECC staff to follow for monitoring/reporting of symptoms and to ensure efficient contact tracing.

Hand sanitizer and regular handwashing breaks will be readily available (all ECC classrooms have a sink). Each classroom, intervention space and shared adult spaces will have a supply of district provided cleaning materials.

Breakfast will be sent home the prior day and lunch will be eaten in the classroom, with the following safety precautions in place:

- Handwashing before & after lunch.
- Safe space provided to accommodate students with allergies.
- Plexiglass barriers in place

Cleaning routines will continue in high-traffic areas & with high-touch surfaces using disinfectants and electro-static spray units that are specific to killing the COVID-19 virus.

Custodial staff will initial cleaning check sheets outside of each space to support contact tracing.

Students encouraged to bring their own water bottles & cups will be available

Any flexible seating will have a wipeable surface.

Intervention Services and SSD:

All MRH intervention services will be in person with safety protocols in place

- Reading, Math, E4, ELL, & Social Emotional supports

SSD services:

Tier 1 students will receive in person services

SSD staff will support students as needed with social stories to assist with this transition

MRH Virtual Academy students will have the option of in person or virtual services.

- In person services will for virtual students will be determined by staff schedules

Busses



Masks will be required on all busses

Two student per seat (capacity doubled)

Busses will be disinfected between routes/runs
