# MRH COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC FAQ

## Which vaccine will be administered at the vaccination clinics?

Pfizer-BioNTech - which is a two-dose mRNA COVID-19 vaccine series.

## When will I get my 2nd dose?

2nd doses will be given on Friday, May 28th. The appointment time for your 2nd dose will be the same time as your 1st dose on Friday, May 7th.

## Can I receive my 2nd dose of Pfizer-BioNTech at the MRH COVID-19 vaccine clinic if I have already received my 1st dose somewhere else?

We cannot offer any 2nd doses. 1st dose and 2nd dose allocation must match up. Those who have received the 1st dose should see their original provider.

## How long will my appointment last?

Checking your consent form and receiving the vaccine will take about 5 minutes. You will then stay for a minimum of 15 minutes for observation. If you have known allergies, VNA will ask you to wait 30 minutes before returning to work/class.

## What should I bring to my appointment?

- 1) Your insurance card (if you are uninsured, please bring your drivers license or a state ID)
- 2) A photo ID
- 3) A completed VNA consent form signed by a parent or guardian

## How do I select an appointment?

MRH School District will send out a link to select your appointment on Friday, April 30th.

## What if I am uninsured?

If a student is uninsured, they will need to bring a driver's license and VNA will bill the administration fee to the Federal Government.
