In a district where nearly 50% of students qualify for free and reduced lunch prices, for some students the last meal of the week comes on Friday in the form of a government-aided free lunch from the school cafeteria.

To combat this problem, the MRH School District created Weekend on Wheels (WOW). Each Friday, MRH High School students pack boxes of nutritious food, and MRH teachers and staff deliver the boxes to food-insecure families in the district. All pantry food comes from community food drives and donations.

WOW by the Numbers (2014-15)

1,200	Food boxes distributed per year
\$50	Avg value of a weekly food box
15	Teachers volunteering to make deliveries
5	Student WOW interns per semester
30	Avg number of families served weekly
60	Avg number of children served weekly
\$6,200	Dollars raised in 2014-15
\$60,000	Value of food distributed in 2014-15
\$0	MRH funds spent purchasing pantry food
